### ACCREDITATION

Meadowood Manor Personal Care Home is fully accredited. It is dedicated to excellence in personal and extended care in keeping with the standards of Manitoba Health and the Canadian Council on Health Services Accreditation.

### REGULAR RESPITE

The purpose of the Respite Program is to provide short term care for people living in the community whose needs for supervision and nursing care are normally met by their family/significant others. Respite care provides temporary physical and emotional relief for the caregiver which enables them to continue caring for the person at home.



### ADMISSIONS

Admission to Respite is coordinated by the Winnipeg Regional Health Authority—Home Care. An assessment is done by Home Care Staff in your area.

For more information on arranging Respite, call 940-2655 and an Intake Specialist will help you. Or, if you are already receiving home care services, contact your Home Care Case Coordinator.

Admission time is 1:30 p.m. On Tuesdays.

### SERVICES PROVIDED

- 24 hour nursing care & supervision.
- Prescribed medications & treatments.
- Meals & Snacks
- Special Diets are accommodated as prescribed by the physician.
- Laundry & Housekeeping.
- X-ray & Lab Services.
- Family Room & Lounges for get-togethers and visiting.
- Hair Stylist & Salon (nominal fee)
- Social Work Services.
- Recreation Programs.
- Pastoral Care & Religious Services.

## WE SUGGEST YOU BRING THE FOLLOWING:

- 5 changes of washable clothing.
- 6 pairs of socks.
- 2 warm sweaters.
- 1 robe, 1 pair non-skid slippers.
- 3 nightgowns or pajamas (6 pairs if there is incontinence).
- Comfortable supportive shoes.
- Any equipment used (can, walker, wheelchair, glasses, hearing aides, batteries, etc.)
- Kleenex, electric shaver, deodorant, toothbrush & paste, denture tablets, hairbrush, and any other toiletries.
- Seasonal outerwear.
- Special pillow, family photos, books.



All clothing brought to the Manor is labeled by our laundry staff for a fee of \$10.00.

## TELEPHONE

Clients may use the phone at the Nursing Station.

## CABLE TV

A television and access to cable TV is provided in the resident's respite room.

## VISITING



Visitors are welcome at anytime.

Pets are also welcome, but should be on a leash and must have their vaccinations up to date.

Visitor parking is available in front of the Manor. For security reasons the main entrance is locked at night, but access can be gained by using the intercom system at the front door.

## COSTS

Respite clients are charged the current minimum daily residential cost. Clients are asked to pay this on admission. (This cost can be claimed on income tax).

## NOTE

Meadowood Manor is a nonsmoking facility.
